GRADE 12 NEWS:

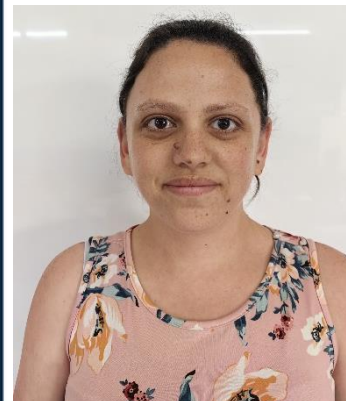
